

WHEREAS, Ms. Tresselt brought enthusiasm, humor, warmth, dedication and loyalty to all her endeavors at CSU, therefore, be it


RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees of the Connecticut State University System confers emeritus status upon Sally Tresselt effective June 1, 2000, and be it further
