EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The following three gifts comply with the Board's policy which requires that cash gifts of more than \$25,000 be brought to the Trustees for acceptance:

1) Gift of \$300,000 from the ECSU Foundation, Inc. made possible by the donation of a grant from Connecticut Light and Power Company to support the services of the Institute for Sustainable Energy in meeting its objectives.

2) Gift of \$75,000 from the ECSU Foundation, Inc. made possible by the donation of a grant from the Energy Conservation Management Board to support the services of the Institute for Sustainable Energy in meeting its objectives.

3) Gift of \$75,000 from the ECSU Foundation, Inc. made possible by the donation of a grant from the Davis Educational Foundation as second year funding to support the services of assessment facilitators/coordinators for the two-year program to implement an assessment for improvement project.
