### RESOLUTION

### concerning

### REDUCTION OF FY2004-05 TUITION RATES

### June 14, 2004

WHEREAS,	The Board of Trustees under its statutory authority - CGS 10a-99 - reviews and
	establishes fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

- WHEREAS, FY2004-05 tuition and fee rates were approved by the Board of Trustees in December of 2003, and
- WHEREAS, At that time, the Board acknowledged that if there were partial or full restoration of a \$7.8 million shortfall contained in the FY05 year of the State's biennial budget, they would consider reducing FY2004-05 tuition and fee rates, and
- WHEREAS, The Governor has signed into law the FY2005 Legislative Budget, which provides CSU with funding totaling \$137,747,000 and restores \$4.9 million of the shortfall, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the rate increase for tuition be reduced to 8.1% from the previously approved 13.7%, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the rates reflected on the attached schedules (1 7) are effective at each university and *OnlineCSU* as appropriate for FY2004-05, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #03-64 is amended to reflect this change.

### **ITEM**

Reduction of FY2004-05 Tuition Rates

### **BACKGROUND**

The Board of Trustees under its statutory authority - CGS 10a-99 - reviews and establishes fees annually for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary. Recommendations are developed through a process which involves discussions among university and System Office management and Trustees. Discussions generally focus upon issues relating to university programmatic needs and priorities, the cost to students, the economy, political considerations, and other factors. Additionally, students are advised of the proposed tuition and fee recommendations and voice their concurrence or non-concurrence. Tuition and fees for FY2005 were approved by the Board of Trustees in December of 2003.

### **ANALYSIS**

The Governor has signed into law the FY2005 Legislative Budget, which provides CSU with funding totaling \$137,747,000, and restores \$4.9 million of an estimated \$7.8 million shortfall. The restored funding will be used to fund collective bargaining increases. In recognition of this restoration of funding, it is proposed that the average increase in Tuition and Fees be reduced from 12.48% to 9.59%, a savings of \$148 per year for in-state undergraduate commuter students from the previously approved rates. The entire reduction is proposed to be taken from the Tuition line, so that the tuition increase will be reduced from 13.7% to 8.1%.

It is recognized that this proposal may cause certain operational issues at the universities (e.g. financial aid (which has already been awarded in many cases) and billing), and that flexibility will be required in implementing this recommendation.

### CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION

Approve the reduction of the approved FY2004-05 Tuition and Required Fees rates by an average of 2.89 percentage points, from an average of 12.48% for in-state undergraduate students to an average of 9.59%. The specific components of this proposal would be as follows: Tuition, 8.1%; University General Fee, 17.6%; Information Technology Fee, no change; and University Fee, 4.5%.
