RESOLUTION

concerning

REMISSION OF TUITION FOR OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS

February 7, 1969

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for State Colleges, pursuant to its obligation as set forth in Section 10-116 of the 1967 Supplement to the General Statutes to fix fees for tuition at the State Colleges and make refunds of the same, adopt a policy wherein the amount of tuition remitted to an out-of-state deserving student of exceptional promise will not exceed the tuition fee fixed for residents of Connecticut.

PURPOSE: Section 10-116 of the Statutes indicates that the Board may remit the tuition fee to deserving students. The higher tuition established for out-of-state students was designed to give preference to Connecticut students. To maintain this policy, the amount of tuition remitted to deserving out-of-state students should not exceed that remitted to in-state students.
