Dear Wil:

As per the vote of the Presidents at their meeting on May 16, 1969, this is to request the establishing of the position of Assistant Dean of Students for the State Colleges with the salary groups to be two, three, or four, below that of the Dean of Student Affairs.

All four Colleges are certainly on a year-round schedule and yet in Student Affairs, we have only the Dean of Student Affairs as a twelve-month position. At Central, for example, we have had to recontract for the Summer Session our Dean of Men and Dean of Women for the past several years. The request for this position would allow us to change the positions of Dean of Men and Dean of Women from ten-month faculty positions with the necessity of recontracting to twelve-month administrative positions, thus giving us full coverage of the area of Student Affairs for the entire year.

I would request on behalf of the four Presidents, that this be presented to the Personnel Committee of the Board of Trustees.
