RESOLUTION

concerning

A GUIDELINE FOR DEVELOPING ADMINISTRATIVE SALARIES

February 7, 1969

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for State Colleges, recognizing the need to maintain an equitable relationship between administrative and academic salaries, endorses the use of the following list of ratios as a guideline in developing salaries for administrative positions in the State College system. Any salary proposal based upon this guideline must be approved by the Board of Trustees prior to adoption.
