RESOLUTION

concerning

Connecticut Faculty Talent Search (CONNFACTS)

May 2, 1969

RESOLVED,

That the Board of Trustees of the Connecticut State Colleges endorses the aims and principles underlying the Commission for Higher Education's proposal CONNFACTS: namely, to identify and locate professionally qualified members of the black community who can be considered for employment on the faculties of Connecticut institutions of higher education. Further, the State Colleges will welcome participation in a program which will supplement their current efforts in seeking capable members of minority groups to fill vacancies not only in the faculty but in non-teaching positions.

It is noted, however, that the effective participation of the State Colleges will be conditioned by the extent to which approvals can be obtained to pay the travel costs to bring promising candidates to other colleges and universities to investigate the prospective employees.

The State Colleges recognize the values that can accrue from such a program and offer their support for its successful initiation and operation.
