AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION

concerning

1970-72 State College Enrollments

April 3, 1970

RESOLVED, That pursuant to the authority granted in Section 10-109 of the 1967 Supplement to the General Statutes, the Board of Trustees for State Colleges authorizes enrollments for the fall semesters of 1970, 1971, and 1972 as follows:

REMARKS: The enrollments carried in the resolution include all students supported by the State General Fund.

At the June 6, 1969 meeting, the Board authorized a reduction in the 1969 enrollments to maintain the 386 SCHLDE level. This reduced the originally projected enrollment figure of 16,485 to 15,785. Continuing with the philosophy that the 386 SCHLDE level should be maintained throughout the second year of the biennium, the 1970 enrollment must be reduced from the originally projected figure of 19,235 to 17,772. The 1969 reduction was 700 students and the 1970 reduction is an additional 763 students.

The figures for the 1971-73 biennium are established in an effort to attain the Board's originally projected enrollment of 22,420 in 1972-73. This can be done if the required support is provided in the operating and capital budget appropriations. Without this support it will be necessary to reduce the enrollment figures indicated for that biennium.
