April 30, 1970

WHEREAS, the Board recommended that movement of salaries to the adopted ratios be over a three year period starting in July 1969, be it

RESOLVED, That the salaries of administrators in the State Colleges be established as herein tabulated with an effective date of July 10, 1970, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the present incumbents who thereby qualify be moved onto the listed schedule at the same step as held on the existing 1969-70 salary schedule.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE

BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR STATE COLLEGES

March 6, 1970

The following five principles, unanimously agreed upon by the College Presidents and the Faculty Advisory Committee, were presented to the Personnel Committee for their action.

Following discussion with the Presidents and Advisory Committee members, the Personnel Committee endorsed the stated principles and recommends them to the Board of Trustees for their approval.

- 1. The sum of money to be included in the requested Budget for 1971-73 in order to provide for a major adjustment in faculty salaries shall be sufficient to guarantee a minimum salary increase of 10 percent for each faculty member in the State Colleges, in addition to the annual increment for each year of the biennium.
- 2. Within the gross amount requested, there will be greater percentage adjustment for the ranks of Associate Professor and Professor, than for Instructor and Assistant Professor:
- 3. The sum of money appropriated for the adjustment of salaries by the Legislature will be the basis for the formulation of the new faculty salary schedule which will be arrived at after consultation with the Advisory Council to the Board of Trustees.
- 4. The percentage increase will have to be considered in the light of any possible general increase for State employees appropriated by the Legislature.
- 5. The requested sum of money under principle I above shall be placed in the Budget as a top priority item.
