RESOLUTION
concerning
Eminent Domain Proceedings
Western Connecticut State College

February 5, 1971

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for the State Colleges considers the expansion of the physical facilities of the State Colleges a matter of extreme urgency; and

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Connecticut has appropriated monies for the expansion and construction of new buildings and facilities for the State Colleges; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for the State Colleges has found it necessary for the expansion of Western Connecticut State College, that certain property located between U. S. Route 6 and the presently owned campus site in the City of Danbury be acquired; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for the State Colleges acting through the Public Works Department of the State of Connecticut as its agent has been unable to successfully negotiate for the acquisition of certain property in the City of Danbury: Therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges requests the Attorney General of the State of Connecticut to acquire by eminent domain proceedings the following properties for which monies have been provided and authorized by the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut:

concerning
Eminent Domain Proceedings
for Land Acquisition at
New Campus for Western Connecticut State College

December 7, 1973

WHEREAS, the Trustees have approved the acquisition of parcels of land to establish a major entry to the new campus site of Western Connecticut State College, and

WHEREAS, the owners of such parcels of land have refused to sell their property, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has recommended that eminent domain proceedings to acquire such land be instituted, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges requests the

Attorney General of the State of Connecticut to acquire by eminent
domain proceedings 3.035 acres and 9.294 acres of land of

A. Peter Damia in Danbury, Connecticut for the expansion of
the facilities at Western Connecticut State College, said
parcels to be acquired subject to whatever encumbrances and reservations as meet with the approval of the State Public Works
Department.
