AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION

concerning

Tuition for Part-time Students

at the

Connecticut State Colleges

January 7, 1972

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges is required by Public Act No. 5 (1971 General Assembly, Section 123a) to fix fees for tuition of not less than three hundred dollars for residents of this state and not less than eight hundred fifty dollars for non-residents; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is mandated also to prorate the above tuition for students carrying less than seventy-five percent of the credit hours defined as a full-time load, be it hereby

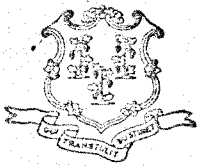
RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes the imposition of part-time tuition rates as reflected in the attached schedule to be effective January 1972.

PART-TIME TUITION RATES, BEGINNING JANUARY 1972

Public Act 5, Section 126(b): In order to defray part of the cost of the higher education instructional programs at the constituent units of the state system of higher education, TUITION SHALL BE CHARGED AS PROVIDED IN SECTIONS 122 to 125, INCLUSIVE, OF THIS ACT for each full-time student or shall be prorated in the case of a student carrying less than seventy-five percent of the credit hours defined as a full-time load by the institution, such sum to be deposited to the resources of the general fund in accordance with Section 4-32 and notwithstanding the provisions of any other general statute or special act.

Subject: Part-time tuition rates, second semester, 1971-72

Following sessions with representatives of the different constituent units and a discussion with an associate attorney general, the Commission for Higher Education, at its November meeting, adopted the attached set of part-time tuition rates to serve as guides to the units in setting rates for the semester or term beginning in January, 1972.

In line with its responsibility to approve fees set by the respective Boards of Trustees for tuition and other purposes, this action was taken to arrive at a consistent pattern in setting part-time rates.
