

INASMUCH as the primary mission of the State Colleges by policy is to provide academic programs at the baccalaureate and graduate levels, See Reso. #78-28-Vol. VI-E-

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Associate of Science degree programs in secretarial science, accounting and marketing at Central Connecticut State College be phased out, beginning September 1, 1972. Students presently enrolled in one of these programs will be allowed to complete their degree program, but no new students will be admitted.

Resolutions Adopted by the Board

It was the recommendation of the Planning Committee that certain resolutions be adopted by the Board.

1. New program - CCSC

Moved by Mr. Robinson, seconded by Mr. Dyer, the following resolution was approved.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges hereby authorizes Central Connecticut State College to begin a Master of Science and 6th Year Program in Educational Supervision and Curriculum Development effective September 1972, or as soon thereafter as practicable.

2. N.D.S.L. Program - Collections

Moved by Mr. Robinson, seconded by Dr. Cammarano, the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges, in accordance with the authority vested under Section 10-109b of the General Statutes, hereby authorizes the Executive Secretary to enter into an agreement with the Division of Central Collections of the Department of Finance and Control whereby said Division shall provide services to the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges for the purpose of effecting the collection of delinquent accounts of the National Defense Student Loan program.
