RESOLUTION

concerning

CAREER EDUCATION REPORT AND POLICIES

December 7, 1973

- WHEREAS, The Trustees have reviewed the report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Career Education; and
- WHEREAS, The Trustees have also reviewed the comments concerning the report made by the Student Advisory Board, the Faculty Advisory Council, and the Council of College Presidents; and
- WHEREAS, The Trustees are in support of the principles and recommendations stated in the report; be it
- RESOLVED, That the Trustees accept the report and announce their approval of the principles and recommendations made in it, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Trustees approve the establishment of an Advisory

 Committee on Career Education; that the membership of the

 Committee shall include not more than sixteen persons selected

 from among the leaders of business, industry, government, and

 social agencies as well as one person from each of the follow
 ing groups students, alumni, and faculty; that the chairman

 of the Committee be a member of the Board of Trustees; and

 that the chairman of the Committee and the members of the

 Committee shall be designated by the chairman of the Board of

 Trustees, and be it

- RESOLVED, That members of the Advisory Committee shall serve for two years parallel with the terms Board members serve on committees of the Board, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Advisory Committee shall report to the Trustees through the appropriate committee or committees of the Board within one year from this date on the progress of the State Colleges toward the goals stated in the report and on any recommendations the Advisory Committee may have in regard to career education and that thereafter the Advisory Committee shall submit reports from time to time as is appropriate.
