RESOLUTION

concerning
Eminent Domain Proceedings
for Land Acquisition at
New Campus for Western Connecticut State College

December 7, 1973

WHEREAS, the Trustees have approved the acquisition of parcels of land to establish a major entry to the new campus site of Western Connecticut State College, and

WHEREAS, the owners of such parcels of land have refused to sell their property, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has recommended that eminent domain proceedings to acquire such land be instituted, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges requests the Attorney General of the State of Connecticut to acquire by eminent domain proceedings 3.035 acres and 9.294 acres of land of A. Peter Damia in Danbury, Connecticut for the expansion of the facilities at Western Connecticut State College, said parcels to be acquired subject to whatever encumbrances and reservations as meet with the approval of the State Public Works Department.
