RESOLUTION

concerning

FINANCIAL ADJUSTMENT FOR UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES HOLDING THE ACADEMIC RANK

of

PROFESSOR, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, ASSISTANT PROFESSOR, INSTRUCTOR,

and

ASSISTANT INSTRUCTOR

February 1, 1974

WHEREAS, Neighboring states have moved ahead of Connecticut in the level of salaries paid for comparable positions, thereby weakening our State's competitive position in the recruitment and retention of faculty members, and

WHEREAS, The salary schedule now used for unclassified persons employed by the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges of Connecticut in these positions generally provides compensation at a rate below that of similar employees of the University of Connecticut and the Technical Colleges and provides compensation at a level similar to that of the Regional Community Colleges, and

WHEREAS, The Commission for Higher Education has recommended salary adjustments to correct these discrepancies, and

WHEREAS, Certain employees in these positions received no increment during the fiscal year 1973-74 because they had previously reached the final step for their salary group, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, 1. That, exercising the authority provided in Section 10-109b of the General Statutes the Board of Trustees declares that, the following changes in the salary schedule and the following salary adjustments are authorized.

a. The salary groups for Professors shall be raised to 27, 28, and 29 from the present level of 26; and the present incumbents may be placed in group 27 or group 28 in the manner specified in the addendum to this resolution. The Trustees do not authorize the use of salary group 29 at this time but will do so at a later date when budgetary conditions warrant such action.

ADDENDUM

RESOLUTION #74-1 of FEBRUARY 1, 1974 concerning

FINANCIAL ADJUSTMENT FOR UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, ASSISTANT PROFESSOR,
INSTRUCTOR AND ASSISTANT INSTRUCTOR

1. Alleligible employees, except full professors who are now on step 6 of salary group 26, who have not benefited under Section 2 of the resolution, may be placed on that step which provides the immediately higher salary than the salary from which advanced after augmentation by the amount of one increment of the higher salary group. Full professors who are now on step 6 of salary group 26 may be placed on that step of their new salary group which provides the immediately higher salary than the salary from which advanced after augmentation by the amount of two increments of the higher salary group. The maximum increase, including annual increments, shall not exceed those provided in the following table.
