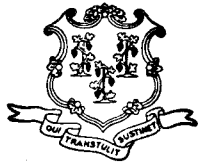

Undergraduate credit -- from \$30 to \$32 per credit hour
Graduate credit -- from \$35 to \$40 per credit hour
