WHEREAS, The General Assembly at its 1976 Regular Session has revised Section 10-116(a) of the General Statutes to provide a full-time tuition increase from \$300.00 to \$390.00 for residents of this state and from \$850.00 to \$1,030.00 for nonresidents, be it

RESOLVED, That effective July 1, 1976, part-time tuition rates set forth in the addendum to this resolution shall supersede the part-time tuition rates authorized by the resolution of January 7, 1972.

PART-TIME TUITION RATES, BEGINNING FALL TERM OR SEMESTER 1976

Section 10-329b(b): In order to defray part of the cost of the higher education instructional programs at the constituent units of the state system of higher education, tuition shall be ... prorated in the case of a student carrying less than 75% of the credit hours defined as a full-time load by the institution.
