

- WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees resolved on July 18, 1975 to discontinue operation of the F. R. Noble School; and
- WHEREAS, In order to give a full year's notice to faculty of F. R. Noble School, the Board of Trustees set their termination date as December 15, 1976; and
- WHEREAS, Several members of that faculty have secured employment elsewhere and no longer remain on the payroll; and
- WHEREAS, Four members of the F. R. Noble School faculty, not yet having secured new employment for the fall term 1976, may remain on the payroll until the aforementioned 15th day of December, 1976, unless they secure new employment in advance of that date; and
- WHEREAS, There is no professional work currently available at the College for which the qualifications of these faculty members would recommend suitable placement; and,
- WHEREAS, A temporary assignment working for the Windham School District might possibly lead to permanent employment; and
- WHEREAS, The College is both beholden to the town for past services and dedicated to the concept of cooperative endeavor; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the President of Eastern Connecticut State College is authorized to negotiate a temporary loan of the services of these four faculty members to the school system of the Town of Windham until December 15, 1976, or until such prior time as they may find other employment; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That should the loan negotiations fail, the President of Eastern Connecticut State College is authorized to assign, until December 15, 1976, such duties as may seem best to fit the needs of the College without reference to the particular training and professional skills of the faculty members involved.
