concerning

USE OF 1/2 OF 1% FOR PROGRAM CHANGE

May 5, 1978

WHEREAS, In Resolution #78-22, dated April 14, 1978, the Trustees set aside 1/2 of 1% of the 1978-1979 General Fund Operating Budget for Program Change, and

WHEREAS, The Trustees' Planning Committee has considered proposals submitted by each of the Colleges for use of the fund reserved for program change, and has recommended certain new programs as being appropriate for implementation, and

WHEREAS, The State laws and regulations concerning the expenditure of public monies must be scrupulously observed, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the following projects are approved within the indicated financial limits at:

1. Program of Instruction in Integrated Computer Applications
