RESOLUTION

concerning

INCREASE IN COLLEGE GENERAL FEE, SCR #77-13

June 9, 1978

WHEREAS, Section 10-116 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for State Colleges, subject to the approval of the Board of Higher Education, shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, State College Resolution #77-13, as amended by State College Resolution #77-25, sets forth approved College General Fee rates currently in effect, and

WHEREAS, It has become necessary to increase by \$5.00 that portion of the fee applicable to intercollegiate athletics at Eastern Connecticut State College, and

WHEREAS, The Student Senate and the college administration of Eastern Connecticut State College have recommended that such an increase be authorized by the Trustees, be it

RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Higher Education, the Board of Trustees for Connecticut State Colleges authorizes, effective for the fall semester of 1978, the amendment of State College Resolution #77-13 to provide an increase in the College General Fee at Eastern Connecticut State College from \$99 to \$104 per academic year for the purpose of meeting additional costs of intercollegiate athletics, the amended schedule of College General Fees for the four State Colleges to be as follows:


