WHEREAS, Historic Resources Survey, a non-profit civic organization located in Willimantic, Connecticut, desires to use space in Nathan Hale Hall at Eastern Connecticut State College for the purpose of carrying out a CETA-6 project sponsored by the Regional Planning agency, and

WHEREAS, There presently is space available in Nathan Hale Hall which will not be used by the college in the immediate future, and

WHEREAS, The college administration believes that the proposed project will be of benefit to the State of Connecticut and that it is appropriate to the purposes of an educational institution, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for State Colleges authorizes, without charge, the use by Historic Resources Survey of space in Nathan Hale Hall known as Room 112, and be it

RESOLVED, That such authorization is subject to the following stipulations:

- 1. That the proposed use shall have the approval of the State Fire Marshal.
- 2. That approval for the arrangement shall be given by the appropriate State agencies.
- 3. That Historic Resources Survey shall provide all required insurance coverages.
- 4. That Historic Resources Survey shall provide all cleaning and maintenance for areas used.
- 5. That the arrangement can be canceled by either party at any time through a sixty-day written notice.

Dear Dr. Webb:

Thank you for your letter of the third. I have inspected room 112 in the Nathan Hale Hall and it would be adequate for our purposes. I understand that parking space is at a premium. We would still appreciate the loan of desks and typewriters, if you could make them available. We will assume responsibility for maintenance and any insurance requirements.

The CETA -6 project will be sponsored by the Regional Planning Agency. It will employ twelve persons. The project can best be described as a continuation of the 1930's Writers' Project Manuscript Catalog which was never completed. We will inventory local and state holdings and write an annotated catolog of the manuscript sources for the history of Northeastern Connecticut, oral histories of two or more towns, and possibly write a secondary school field trip guide. I have to discuss this further with Superintendent Vaughn Clapp of Chaplin. We will work on the history of the early mills and the ethnic groups that staffed them.

As of this date, the project has been endorsed by Dr. Thomas Anderson of your History Department, Dr. Albert Van Dusen, Historian of the State of Connecticut, and Dr. Richard Brown, Head, Department of History, University of Connecticut. Copies of their letters of support are available on request.

Please let me know if you need any more information. Thank you for your interest in this project.

With reference to your letter of August 2, 1978, I can indeed tell you that we have gotten a verbal go ahead from the fire marshall. I am unable, however, to give you anything positive until (1) the fire marshall has given us something in writing, and (2) the Board of Trustees has approved the use of the facility for this purpose. With reference to the letter, I can present your request to the Planning Committee of the Board at its meeting August 16. It will be helpful to me with reference to that meeting if you would submit a short statement prior to August 9, 1978, briefly outlining the project and the purpose to which the space will be used. In any arrangement agreed to between the College and the Historic Resources Survey, the latter will assume full responsibility for cleaning and maintaining the space it occupies and will provide whatever insurance and/or assurances state law and College regulations may require.

I would suggest meanwhile that you visit the Nathan Hale to see if Room 112 will give you sufficient space; I have looked at this room and it appears to me to be adequate. I cannot at this time promise you the student lounge. With reference to the two typewriters, two typewriter tables, one desk and swivel chair, I can make no promises in this regard. We can try to help you. As for the four assigned parking spaces, I'm sorry I have none to offer you.




