

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

February 2, 1979

- WHEREAS, The Trustees desire to continue the Student Accident Insurance Program for the year 1979-80 for full-time students, and
- WHEREAS, The Aetna Life Insurance Company has indicated that benefits can be increased in 1979-80 as shown in the attached schedule, without an increase in rates effective for 1978-79, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the contract with the Aetna Life Insurance Company through Goodwin, Loomis, and Britton, Inc. for student accident insurance is approved for renewal for the year 1979-80 with the understanding that the premium cost for such insurance shall remain the same as for 1978-79 and that benefits will be increased according to the attached schedule.

Schedule of Increased Benefits

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Primary

Full reimbursement for all expenses up to \$1,000 except maximum benefit for dental treatment is \$100

Major Medical

80% reimbursement for all expenses from \$1,000 to \$12,000 except maximum benefit for dental treatment is \$400.

Intercollegiate Sports Injuries

Full reimbursement for all expenses up to \$12,000 except maximum benefit for dental treatment is \$500.

Accidental Death & Dismemberment

If an accident occurs while the insured is engaged in practicing for, traveling directly to or from or participating in an intercollegiate athletic event as a member of an intercollegiate athletic team sponsored by a Connecticut State College, Aetna Life will pay the benefits shown in the schedule below:

Loss of Life \$2,500

Loss of both hands, both feet, sight of both eyes or any combination thereof \$2,500

Full reimbursement for all expenses up to \$12,000 except maximum benefit for dental treatment is full coverage to \$500. (Non-sports as well as sports related accidents.)

Accidental Death & Dismemberment

If an accident occurs while the insured is practicing for, engaging in, or traveling directly to or from an official college activity of a Connecticut State College as a participant in an officially recognized college organization or department, Aetna Life will pay the benefits shown in the schedule below:

Loss of Life \$2,500

Loss of both hands, both feet, sight of both eyes or any combination thereof \$2,500
