MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

March 9, 1979

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for State Colleges by Resolutions #79-14 and #79-15, dated February 2, 1979, approved a mandatory sickness insurance plan for the year 1979-1980 at the rate of \$36 per student with benefits as shown on the attachment to Resolution #79-15, and

WHEREAS, The agent of record, Goodwin, Loomis and Britton, has agreed to a technical adjustment in regard to the sickness limit as indicated on said attachment, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the sickness limit be increased from \$6,000 to \$12,000.
