#### MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS


March 9, 1979

- WHEREAS, The agent of record, Goodwin, Loomis and Britton, has agreed to a technical adjustment in regard to the sickness limit as indicated on said attachment, now therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the sickness limit be increased from \$6,000 to \$12,000.





The attached resolution mandating a Medical Insurance Fee for all full-time foreign students was adopted by our Board on February 2.

This fee will not become official until approved by the Board of Higher Education. Although we do not anticipate problems in obtaining BHE approval, the process will probably take two or even three months.

Therefore, I suggest that you alert both your admissions director and your business office that if the fee is approved by the BHE, it will have to be collected for Fall, 1979.

WHEREAS, Such foreign students in time of need have no local families to

turn to and are not eligible for public assistance, now, therefore,

be it

RESOLVED, That all foreign students who are enrolled as full-time students

shall pay a Foreign Student Medical Insurance Fee to provide such

sickness insurance coverage as is contracted for by the Connecticut

State Colleges.
