### RESOLUTION



PROFESSOR ABRAHAM GROSSFELD

- WHEREAS, Professor Abie Grossfeld, as a gymnast, represented the United States for 15 consecutive years on 26 international teams performing in 35 countries, including the Olympic Games in 1956 and 1960, and
- WHEREAS, He has coached the United States teams at the 1966 World Championships and the Olympic Games at Munich in 1972, and
- WHEREAS, He has coached John Crosby, who was a member of the 1972 U.S. Olympic team, and Peter Kormann, who won a bronze medal at the 1976 Olympic Games, and
- WHEREAS, He has coached at Southern Connecticut State College three National Collegiate Athletic Association Division II championship teams, and has placed Southern teams among the top five nationally in Division I during the past three seasons, and
- WHEREAS, He has thus brought national and international recognition to Southern Connecticut State College and the State of Connecticut, and
- WHEREAS, He has recently been honored by being elected to the Gymnastics Hall of Fame for outstanding service as a performer, coach and contributor to the support of gymnastics, now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State Colleges offers its congratulations to Professor Grossfeld for his distinguished career in gymnastics and for his superb service as a teacher and coach at Southern Connecticut State College, and wishes him continued success in his professional endeavors.
