concerning

TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE COLLEGES

April 3, 1981

WHEREAS, Tuition for the Connecticut State Colleges has remained constant since 1976 despite a high level of inflation during the intervening years, and

WHEREAS, The State is now in straitened financial circumstances, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That tuition be increased by \$25 a semester for a new rate of \$220 per semester for residents of this State effective July 1, 1981.


