
With this letter, I submit my application for the position of Dean, School of Arts and Sciences of Western Connecticut State College. Though my professional experience in teaching and administration has been with one institution for twenty-one years (Saint Peter's College, with a principal campus in Jersey City and a smaller campus at Englewood Cliffs), the experience has been one of breadth:

- 1) fifteen years (1959-71, 1972-75) as full-time teacher in the Department of Chemistry (six full-time teachers in the Department) receiving the Saint Peter's College Alumni Distinguished Teacher Award in 1975;
- 2) in sixth year (1975 to present) as the principal Academic Dean of the College with chief responsibility for the Day Session (about 2800 students, 2100 full-time), with all Department Chairpersons reporting to my Office;
- 3) one year (1978-79) as Chief Academic Officer of the College serving in both the capacity of Academic Dean and Academic Vice President during the first year of a new President of the College;
- 4) one year (1971-72) serving full-time as Executive Director for the extensive celebration of the College's Centennial.


