#### RESOLUTION

#### Concerning

#### AN INCREASE IN EDUCATIONAL EXTENSION FUND FEES

June 12, 1981

- WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for State Colleges, on October 3, 1980, passed Board Resolution #80-134 authorizing an increase in Educational Extension Fund Fees, a resolution which never was submitted to the Board of Higher Education for approval, and
- WHEREAS, Projections through the 1982-1983 fiscal year show deficits developing in varying degree at each of the State Colleges, and
- WHEREAS, An immediate raising of credit hour fees will result in a more moderate increase than would be required if fee increases were delayed until a later date, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #80-134, dated October 3, 1980, is hereby rescinded, and be it
- RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Higher Education, the Board of Trustees for State Colleges authorizes, effective for the Fall 1981 semester, credit hour fees for the Educational Extension Programs, Summer Sessions, and Intersessions not to exceed the following:

Undergraduate courses	\$58 per credit hour
Graduate courses other than those leading to a Sixth-Year Certificate	\$70 per credit hour
Graduate courses leading to a Sixth-Year Certificate	\$75 per credit hour

WHEREAS, The Educational Extension Fund is operating at a serious deficit and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to provide additional funds by the beginning of the second semester in the current academic year, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That, if the Board of Higher Education approves, the Executive Director may raise fees for courses taken under the program provided by the Educational Extension Fund as follows:

- 1) For undergraduate courses to a level of not more than \$58 per credit hour.
- 2) For graduate courses other than those leading to a Sixth-Year Certificate to a level of not more than \$70 per credit hour.
- 3) For graduate courses leading to a Sixth-Year Certificate to a level of not more than \$75 per credit hour.


