Dear Jim:

I am pleased to inform you that Dr. Louis Kuslan, Professor of Chemistry and former Dean of the School of Arts and Sciences, has donated a number of chemical journals to Southern Connecticut State College to be housed in our new science building. These journals will provide a working reference library close to the teaching, research and office facilities.

The journals are:

I. Chemical Abstracts

From vol. 1, 1907 to vol. 56, 1962, including the Decennial Indexes, 1907-1916, 1917-1926, 1927-1936, 1937-1946, 1947-1965, and the 6th Collective Index, 1957-1961. This is a total of some 275 bound volumes.

Alfred Jaeger's catalogue of periodicals for sale, 1980, lists volumes 1-10 at \$225 per volume, and later years at from \$20.00 to \$45.00 per volume. Decennial Indexes are quoted at from \$300 to \$475, while the 5th Decennial Index is priced at \$2,000.

These journals are in very good to fine condition.

II. Journal of the American Chemical Society

From vol. 52, 1930 to vol. 85, 1963, 89 bound volumes in very good to fine condition. These are priced by Alfred Jaeger at \$10 per volume.

III. Biological Abstracts From vol. 1, 1926-1927 to vol. 32, 1958, including both parts, A and B, and F from 1942 to 1945, a total of 74 bound volumes
