I would appreciate having this gift brought to the attention of, and acknowledged by, the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State Colleges.

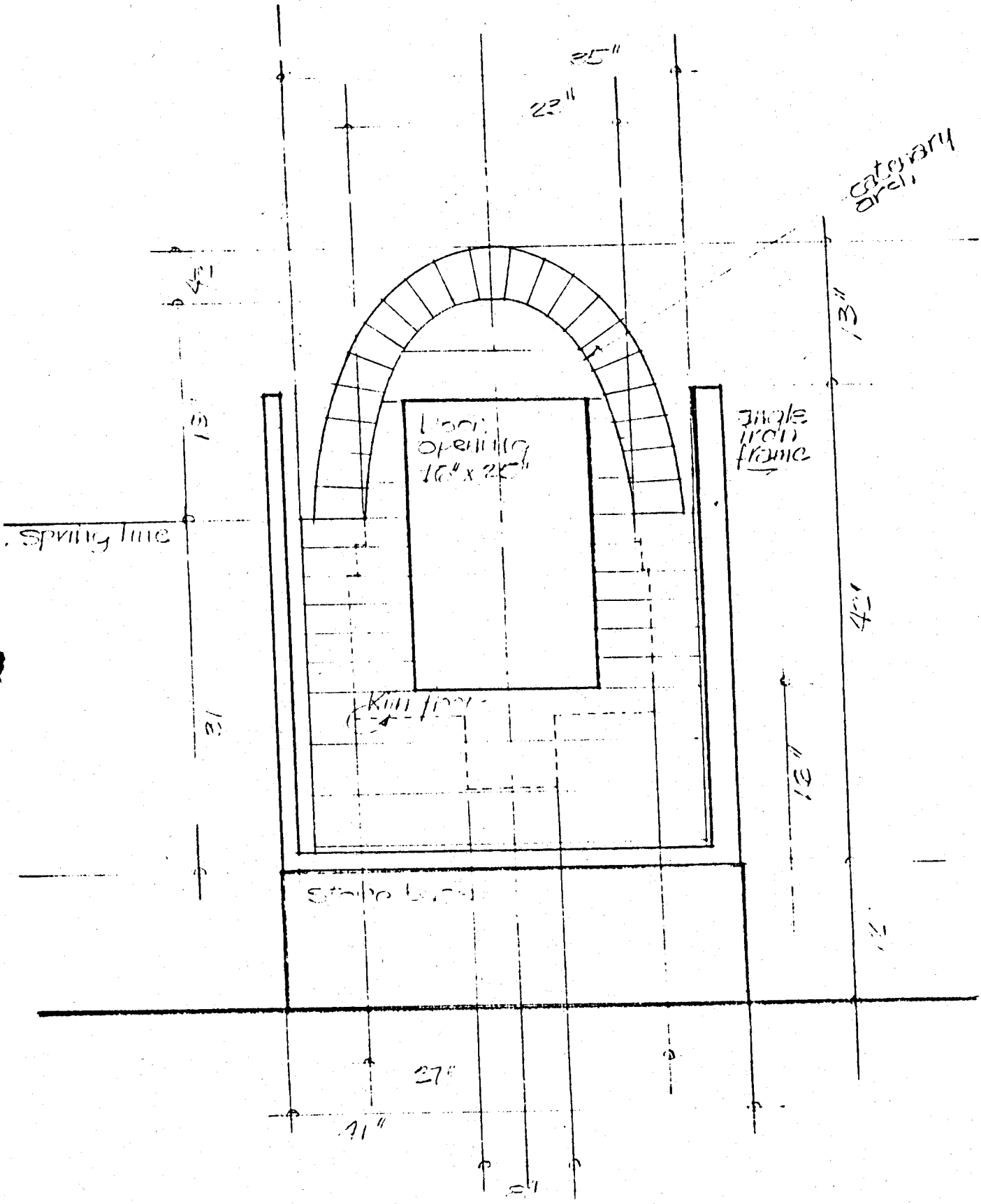
