March 5, 1982

- Serious inroads have been made by inflation into the WHEREAS, level of General Fund support for the programs of the State Colleges, and
- Its financial circumstances are such that the State WHEREAS, cannot be expected to provide funding adequate to offset the ravages of inflation, be it
- That, subject to the approval of the Board of Higher RESOLVED, Education, the rate of Tuition charged to State College students shall be increased by \$22 per semester to a total of \$242 per semester (\$484 per academic year) for residents of Connecticut and that the rate of Tuition charged to non-residents shall be increased by \$52 per semester to a total of \$567 per semester (\$1,134 per academic year), both increases to be effective July 1, 1982.
