AN INCREASE IN THE STATE COLLEGE STUDENT FEE

May 7, 1982

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees, on March 5, 1982, passed Board Resolution No. 82-8, increasing the annual State College Student Fee by \$50 for both resident and non-resident students, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Higher Education, meeting on April 20, 1982, did not approve the \$50 increase but, instead, approved a \$30 annual increase in the State College Student Fee, be it

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution No. 82-8 is rescinded and that State College Student Fee rates, as established by Board Resolution No. 71-30, dated April 2, 1971, shall be increased from \$75 to \$90 per semester (\$180 per academic year) for residents of Connecticut and from \$250 to \$265 per semester (\$530 per academic year) for non-residents, to be effective beginning with the Fall semester of the academic year 1982-1983.

AN INCREASE IN THE STATE COLLEGE STUDENT FEE

March 5, 1982

WHEREAS, Escalating costs, new residence hall construction and diminishing enrollments all are expected to contribute significantly to the need for additional funding for debt service and for major repairs and renovations for self-supporting facilities (residence halls, dining halls and student centers), be it

RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Higher Education, the State College Student Fee rates, as established by Board Resolution #71-30, dated April 2, 1971, shall be increased from \$75 to \$100 per semester (\$200 per academic year) for residents of Connecticut and from \$250 to \$275 per semester (\$550 per academic year) for non-residents, to be effective beginning with the Fall semester of the academic year 1982-1983.
