RESOLVED, That the existing Division of Social Work is redesignated the School of Social Work.



Creation of Schools and a Position of Dean

I understand that both the Planning Committee and the Personnel Committee of the Board of Trustees will meet on September 1, 1982. I propose that at this meeting we seek their approvals, respectively, of the creation of three schools and a dean for Social Work.
