POSITION SUMMARY:

The Director is responsible for the overall supervision and administration of the intercollegiate and intramural athletic programs of the University.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Supervise the organization and administration of the intercollegiate athletic program.

Supervise the organization and administration of the intramural athletic program.

In conjunction with chairperson of Physical Education Department, manages athletic facilities of the University.

Advise the President, on a regular basis, of the operations and activities of the Intercollegiate and Intramural Athletics Department.

Serve as head of the Intercollegiate and Intramural Athletics Department and supervise its full- and part-time personnel, as appropriate.

Ensure compliance of all coaches and staff with the rules and regulations governing the operation of the athletic program.

Plan, develop and recommend to the Athletic Board of Control and Awards specific policies procedures, programs, and methods to implement the general athletic philosophy and policies of the University.

Performs other duties and responsibilities related to those enumerated above which do not alter the basic level of responsibility of the position.

QUALIFICATIONS: .

Master's degree, five years' experience in an administrative or coaching position in intercollegiate athletics with at least three years of supervisory and/or head coaching responsibilities in an intercollegiate athletic program required. Soctorate preferred.

These qualifications may be waived for individuals with appropriate alternate experience.
