RESOLUTION

concerning

TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

April 8, 1983

WHEREAS, The Trustees of Connecticut State University are committed to encourage student participation in higher education by providing opportunity within the economic reach of all citizens, and

WHEREAS, Accessible higher education must also be quality higher education and must keep pace with the changing needs of students and society, and

The Trustees recognize the extraordinary financial situation WHEREAS, confronting the General Assembly for fiscal year 1983-84, and

WHEREAS, The Trustees have the responsibility to balance the need to keep Tuition low to insure accessibility with the consideration that for 1983-84 additional resources are needed to maintain quality programs, and

WHEREAS, The Trustees expect that the income raised by such Tuition increase will be returned to the Connecticut State University in the form of an increased General Fund budget for 1983-84, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1983, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students shall be increased as follows:

RESOLVED,

That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 10a-67 of the General Statutes and those of Board Resolution #80-113 as amended by Board Resolution #82-53, and subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1983, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to nonresident students who are enrolled in the Connecticut State University through the New England Regional Student Program shall be \$364 for undergraduates and \$379 for graduate students.
