## concerning

#### AN INCREASE IN EDUCATIONAL EXTENSION FUND FEES

May 6, 1983

WHEREAS, A re-examination of the status of the Educational Extension Fund accounts of the several campuses, giving consideration to the effect of increases in compensation for part-time Lecturers as set forth in a pending collective bargaining agreement and of the projection of credit hour fee needs for the 1983-84 academic year rather than the two-year 1983-85 period, indicates that the fee increases approved in Board Resolution #82-137 exceed currently projected requirements, be it

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #82-137, of December 3, 1982, is rescinded and that, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University authorizes, effective for the Fall 1983 semester, changes in credit hour fees for the Educational Extension Programs, Summer Session, and Intersession as follows:

WHEREAS,	Section 10-116 of the General Statutes provides that the Board
	of Trustees for State Colleges, subject to the approval of the
	Board of Higher Education, shall fix fees for such purposes as
	the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees expects that a moderate rate of inflation, perhaps 7.5% per annum, will continue through the period from July 1, 1983 through June 30, 1985 and,

WHEREAS, Such an increase in costs could impair the financial condition of the Educational Extension Fund accounts of some, if not all, of the State Colleges, be it

RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Higher Education, the Board of Trustees for State Colleges authorizes, effective for the Fall 1983 semester, changes in credit hour fees for the Educational Extension Programs, Summer Sessions, and Intersessions as follows:
