RESOLVED, That those individuals who are employed part-time and are not members of the permanent faculty or staff and whose employment does not include them in the bargaining unit as defined by the State Board of Labor Relations shall be employed in the following category at the salary indicated:

State University Assistant-Negotiable to a maximum of \$3,000 per semester.
