RESOLUTION

concerning

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

January 6, 1984

- WHEREAS, The Trustees desire to continue student accident insurance protection for the year 1984-85 for students who pay General Fund tuition, and
- WHEREAS, Goodwin, Loomis, and Britton, Inc. of Hartford, Connecticut, representing the Peerless Insurance Company of Keene, New Hampshire, has indicated that the benefits can be maintained through 1984-85 with a per student premium increase of \$3.50, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the President of Connecticut State University is authorized to contract with Goodwin, Loomis, and Britton, Inc. as agent for the Peerless Insurance Company for accident insurance for students paying General Fund tuition during 1984-85 at a rate of \$20.00 per student per year with the same benefits as provided by the University's student accident insurance program for the current year.
