RESOLVED, That the salaries of Messrs. Becker and Pernal shall be augmented by \$200 bi-weekly for their services as chief negotiators for a period of one year commencing January 6, 1984, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Executive Director may call upon other persons to facilitate the successful negotiation of the contracts.
