RESOLUTION

concerning

TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

July 26, 1985

WHEREAS, Tuition collected using current rates will not be sufficient to support the Tuition Fund portion of the 1986-87 operating budget of the Connecticut State University, be it

RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1986, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students shall be increased as follows:

	From	
Connecticut Residents: Undergraduate Graduate	\$ 325 410	\$ 360 450
Nonresidents: Undergraduate Graduate	\$1,060 1,140	1,165 1,250

and be it

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 10a-67 of the General Statutes and those of Board Resolution #80-113 as amended by Board Resolution #82-53, and subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1986, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to nonresident students who are enrolled in the Connecticut State University through the New England Regional Student Program shall be \$450 for undergraduate and \$565 for graduate students.
