RESOLUTION

concerning

TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

July 25, 1986

- WHEREAS, Tuition collected using current rates will not be sufficient to support the Tuition Fund portion of the 1987-88 operating budget of the Connecticut State University, be it
- RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1987, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students shall be increased as follows:

	From	To
Connecticut Residents: Undergraduate Graduate	\$ 360 450	\$ 400 500
Nonresidents: Undergraduate Graduate	\$1,165 1,250	\$1,295 1,390

and be it

RESOLVED,

That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 10a-67 of the General Statutes and those of Board Resolution #80-113 as amended by Board Resolution #82-53, and subject to the approval of the Board of Governors of Higher Education, effective July 1, 1987, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to nonresident students who are enrolled in the Connecticut State University through the New England Regional Student Program shall be \$500 for undergraduate and \$625 for graduate students.
