- WHEREAS, The School of Business Economics at Southern Connecticut State University has proposed the establishment of a scholarly organization which would promote interaction among faculties of Business Administration throughout New England and between faculties and the business communities, and
- WHEREAS, The President and the Academic Vice President of Southern Connecticut State University have endorsed this proposal as a means of professional development and intellectual advancement for the faculty of the School of Business Economics and for the discipline of Business Administration, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Trustees of the Connecticut State University authorize administrators and faculty of Southern Connecticut State University to establish the New England Business Administration Association, to locate its principal offices at Southern Connecticut State University, and to incorporate the Association as a non-profit corporation for educational and intellectual purposes and to serve as officers of said corporation.

The School of Business Economics at SCSU has completed its research and is interested in proceeding with the establishment of the New England Business Administration Association.


I have enclosed a copy of the proposed Constitution as well as the Certificate of Registration prepared for submission to the Secretary of the State of Connecticut.

#### NEW ENGLAND BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION ASSOCIATION

#### CONSTITUTION

# Article I

Name: The association, chartered as a non-profit corporation, shall be known as New England Business Administration Association.

#### Article II

<u>Purpose</u>: The purposes of the New England Business Administration Association are:

1. To create a forum for organizing conferences, symposiums, seminars, etc., on contemporary business and academic issues;

2. To establish an effective rapport between academics and the business community for the advancement of business research, application and education programs in the region;

3. To publish a journal and other research and applied materials relating to business;

4. Any other purpose for which such a corporation may be incorporated.

## Article III

<u>Membership</u>: Any individual, organized bureau, division, institute, or center, interested in economic and/or business research may apply for membership. The membership will be granted by the Executive Committee of the Association. An individual may be nominated by the Executive Committee and approved at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors.

#### Article IV

Officers and Election: The New England Business Administration Association shall have a president, a vice-president, a secretary and a treasurer as its officers. These officers shall be elected by the board of directors for terms of one year or until the next board meeting. In case the office of the president becomes vacant, the vice-president shall become president for the remainder of the term and he shall appoint a vice-president for the same period. The other vacancies will be filled by appointment by the Executive Committee for the remainder of the term.

### <u>Article V</u>

<u>Board of Directors</u>: The New England Business Administration Association shall elect eight directors. Four of these, serving staggered terms, must be from the School of Business Economics, Southern Connecticut State University, New Haven, Connecticut. Directors shall be elected at the annual meetings for a period of two years, four directors retiring every year. The Board of Directors shall have power to determine the policies and plans of the Association.

#### Article VI

Executive Committee: The Executive Committee of the New England Business Administration Association shall consist of all the officers and the chairman of the Board of Directors. The Executive Committee shall have the power and duty to implement, through the officers, the policies and plans of the Association laid down by the Board of Directors.

#### Article VII

<u>Permanent Office</u>: The School of Business Economics, Southern Connecticut State University, New Haven, Connecticut, shall be the permanent office of the New England Business Administration Association. Additional local offices may be established in other states.

## Article VIII

<u>By-laws</u>: By-laws of the New England Business Administration Association may be adopted and amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors subject to ratification by the members of the Association at an annual meeting.

#### Article IX

<u>Meetings</u>: The New England Business Administration Association shall hold at least one annual meeting, and may hold as many more meetings as the Board of Directors may deem necessary, for the entire membership.

#### Article X

<u>Membership Fees</u>: The annual membership fees of the New England Business Administration Association shall be proposed by the Executive Committee and approved by the Board of Directors for every year before the annual meeting of the Association.

# Article XI

<u>Amendments</u>: The Constitution of the New England Business Administration Association may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting at any annual meeting provided that no amendment proposal shall be considered unless notice and a copy of the proposed amendment has been sent to each member at least thirty (30) days prior to the annual meeting.
