PRIORITIES FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS

June 19, 1987

BE IT RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #86-87 is rescinded and that priorities for capital projects shall be as follows:

Priority 1 - Projects to eliminate fire, health and other safety hazards.

Projects to eliminate architectural barriers for the handicapped.

Projects to instrument energy conservation measures to provide institutional savings.

- Priority 2 Projects designed to conserve and restore existing facilities for continued use and to protect the State's capital investment.
- Priority 3 Projects to renovate existing facilities to meet new or revised academic programs.
- Priority 4 Projects to provide new facilities when existing facilities cannot be feasibly adapted to meet programmed needs.
