AMENDING RESOLUTION<br>concerning<br>EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENT WORKERS

November 6, 1987

WHEREAS, It is desirable to maximize the benefits of employment under the University Student Worker Program as well as to facilitate scheduling of student workers without interfering with class schedules, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Paragraph e. of Board Resolution \#77-39 which now reads: "... 20 hours per week...." be amended to read as follows:

When classes are in session a student may work no more than 40 hours per bi-weekly pay period, summer sessions excluded.

RESOLUTION
concerning
EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENT WORKERS
May 6, 1977

BE IT RESOLVED, That, in order to establish uniform practices in the employment of student workers, Board Resolution \#77-5a is repealed and the following policies are established effective June 1, 1977.
a. The student must be matriculated at the campus where employed.
b. The student must not be on any State payroll other than the student employee payroll of the employing campus.
c. To be eligible for sumer session work the student aust have been enrolled during the prior semester and must certify in writing his or her intention of attending the College during the next semester, or be completing degree requirements during the summer session.
d. No student may be employed who is carrying less than a nine-semester hour load except in a situation where a student is carrying the courses which will complete his or her requirements for a degree.
e. When classes are in session a student may work no more than 20 hours per week, summer sessions excluded.
f. During vacation periods a student may work a maximum of 40 hours per week, sumer sessions included.
g. The aforementioned policies, a through $I$, shall not apply to persons employed under the Federal College Work Study Program. The employment of persons under the Federal College Work Study Program shall conform to the Federal laws and regulations established for that program.
