RESOLUTION

concerning

AN INCREASE IN THE STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT FEE

December 4, 1987

Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board WHEREAS, of Trustees for the Connecticut State University, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors for Higher Education, shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

Revenue produced at current rates is not sufficient to cover WHEREAS, escalating costs due to inflation, be it

That Board Resolution #82-43 is hereby rescinded, and be it RESOLVED,

RESOLVED, That State University Student Fee rates be increased from \$90 to \$120 per semester (\$240 per academic year) for residents of Connecticut, and from \$265 to \$295 per semester (\$590 per academic year) for nonresidents, to be effective beginning with the Fall semester of the academic year of 1988-89.
