December 2, 1988

WHEREAS, Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors for Higher Education, shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, Revenue produced at current rates is not sufficient to cover escalating costs due to inflation and salary adjustments, be it


RESOLVED, That, if the Board of Governors for Higher Education concurs, effective with the Fall Semester 1989, the charges per academic year per participating student for providing food services shall be changed as follows:
