	addendum to this resolution, and be it


RESOLVED,	That, if the Board of Governors for Higher Education
	concurs, rental rates for rooms to be occupied during the
	summer session shall be prorated in accordance with the fee
	schedule shown in the addendum to this resolution,
	commencing with the Summer Session of 1989, and be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees will review Housing Fees on an annual basis and will request changes, if necessary, before January 1 of each year.
