ESTABLISHING  
THE HONORARY PROFESSORSHIP  
at  
CAMPUSES OF CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

June 16, 1989

- WHEREAS, Certain individuals who are not members of the campus communities of Connecticut State University from time to time make substantial contributions to the academic development of those campuses; and
- WHEREAS, Their contributions are made freely and willingly without compensation, emolument, or perquisite; and
- WHEREAS, The students and faculty of campuses of Connecticut State University benefit appreciably from these contributions; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That presidents of the campuses of Connecticut State University, upon recommendations from appropriate campus bodies, and with the concurrence of the President of Connecticut State University and the Board of Trustees, may award the title of "Honorary Professor" to meritorious and deserving individuals; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That the title of Honorary Professor remain with the recipient for life, although said title shall not be accompanied by compensation, emolument, or perquisite.
