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RESOLVED, That, if the Board of Governors for Higher Education concurs, the State University General Fee per academic year shall be changed as follows, effective for the Fall Semester 1990:

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees will review the University General Fee on an annual basis and will request changes, if necessary, before January 1 of each year.
