- WHEREAS,** Students of the 1950's, 1960's and 1970's planted the trees that lined the walkway between Finis E. Engleman Hall and Irma Pelz Gymnasium at Southern Connecticut State University, trees that were destroyed by the tornado that struck the campus in July 1989, and
- WHEREAS,** The SCSU Alumni Association has supported the restoration of the trees as part of the University's Plant-A-Tree Project, and
- WHEREAS,** The Alumni Association fully funded the planting of new Norway maples along this walkway, and
- WHEREAS,** Thousands of alumni have walked along this well-travelled path during their undergraduate days, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED,** That the Trustees express their appreciation to the Southern Connecticut State University Alumni Association and its 50,000 members for their continuing support of worthy campus projects, and be it further
- RESOLVED,** That, walkway between Finis E. Engleman Hall and the Irma Pelz Gymnasium be named "Alumni Walkway."
